Continuous Improvement in action!

Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) Technology

Overview of the Initiative

In August 2015, a Vertech/Geo Oceans Inspection Team, supported by Legeneering Australia (Habitat), mobilised to the Okha Floating Production and Storage Offtake (FPSO) vessel to use innovative Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) technology to deliver:



- two water ballast tank inspections to meet class requirements;
- General Video Inspection (GVI) survey of the Riser Turret Mooring (including the underside of the RTM, which previously was not possible with Work Class ROVs); and
- remote isolation of a hull penetration using a pneumatic plug, which enabled isolation, valve change out on the internal boiler and de-isolation within a single shift.

Outcomes

All work scopes were safely and successfully delivered within the two week campaign. When compared to traditional methods, such as manned tank entry, divers or larger ROV methods, the innovative approaches led to:



- significant cost and schedule efficiencies;
- increased safety due to unmanned entry;
- higher quality reporting and data collection; and
- reduced permit requirements and disruption to the operational facility.

The joint capabilities of Vertech, Geo Oceans and Legeneering to deliver innovative remote inspection services has the potential to be used across all Woodside offshore assets for long-term benefits, including significant cost savings and risk mitigation.
